
Bursitis

I have been treating more patients with bursitis in the last two months than ever before. What is Bursitis? In short, it is an inflammation of the bursa, which is a small sac of fluid located where muscles and tendons move across bone. Healthy bursae create a smooth surface which makes normal movement painless. If a bursa becomes inflamed, ie Bursitis, then movement becomes stiff and painful.

The most common causes of bursitis are repetitive movement and/or excessive pressure. Bursitis is not discriminating and it can occur in anyone from the physically active to the sedentary office worker, young and old, male and female.

Most commonly affected are shoulders, hips and knees and elbows.

It is important to rule out any infections, and some patients will respond quicker to treatment than others, but all in all bursitis is a condition that can be successfully treated with Bowen therapy.
